I trust in you.

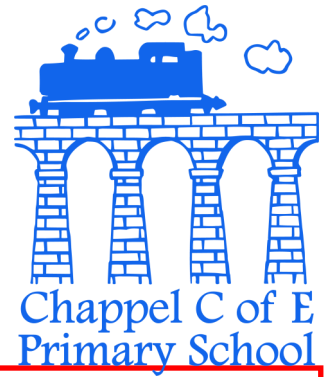

IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

CLASS 1 This week, we have enjoyed learning more about Dinosaurs. We learnt about the different types of dinosaurs and did some wonderful writing about what we would do if we were a dinosaur for a day! We have started some artwork, using art straws to make a dinosaur skeleton.

CLASS 2 This week we have begun to look at climate change-how it affects the oceans and what little things we can each do to help stop it. We have also planted beans and sunflowers in our science lesson. Hopefully they will start to grow soon! In RE, we re-enacted Jesus arriving in Jerusalem, singing Hosannah and waving our palm leaves.

CLASS 3 have embraced Science week investigating the amount of gas in fizzy drinks; seeing biodegradable plastic being made from cornflour, vinegar, glycerine and water. They were also treated to a visit from a Climate Change Champion which linked in with our project work. Alongside all this excitement, the children have had assessment week. They have worked very hard! Thank you to the children for their fabulous poster about an ecological issue, they are very informative.

CLASS 4 have enjoyed finishing their alternative chapters to 'Journey to the river sea.' We have carried out Light experiments in science, demonstrating how refraction works through glass and water. We have looked at the key events in Holy Week that lead up to the crucifixion. Class 4 have worked really hard on their assessments this week, well done!



On Wednesday, Class 3 and 4 had a special visitor. Jill Bruce, the Lead Climate change ambassador for the federation of Essex WI, came in to give a talk about climate change. She explained what has happened to the planet over the years and also how to be Climate Change Superheroes. She was brilliant with the children and has inspired them to make a change.
