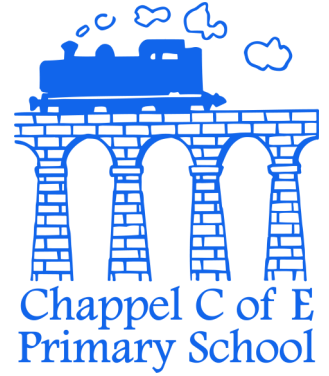
We were so sorry not to

IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK

CLASS 1

This week, we have been naming different dinosaurs and classifying them according to what they ate. We learnt the words carnivore, herbivore and omnivore. We did some writing about dinosaurs and in dance took a journey back in time to explore how different dinosaurs moved. We have also been thinking about the changing seasons and how we know Spring is here.

CLASS 2 have been starting to learn about the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees. Our seeds that we sowed last week are also starting to germinate. In RE, we have been finding out more about the Easter story: we acted out parts of the Last Supper. In addition, we have been making ocean collages, to help us think about how plastic pollution might affect sea creatures.

CLASS 3 have started new topics in Maths - Year 3 Mass & Capacity and Year 4 Decimals. All the children enjoyed learning about earthquakes in Geography, especially creating earthquake proof buildings and testing them on the wobbly jelly!

CLASS 4 have had an amazing week! The children took part in 'The Big Plastic Count' and were shocked by how much plastic we used just in one week. In science, we looked at how the angle of light hitting the mirror is the same as the angle of the light reflected back. The children also created some incredible projects using a range of ideas: plants, canvas paintings, powerpoint presentations and collage. Well done, an impressive week!
