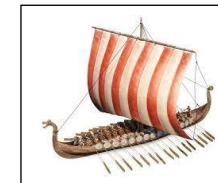


# What a saga!

And be able to use range of sources to compare different eras / understand different representations of past

## As writers we will:

- Read **The Saga of Erik the Viking** by **Terry Jones**. Explore the features of sagas and draw on this understanding to write our own saga
- Write a diary entry expressing the thoughts and feelings of a character
- In comprehension, we will read a range of myths and legends, inferring from the text, and using evidence to support opinions
- In Grammar, we will be revising key terms

## As Mathematicians we will:

- Understand and convert metric and imperial measures, including grams and kg, millilitres and litres, miles and kilometres
- Understand units of time and use timetables
- Know how to find rules and patterns in algebra
- Solve simple equations
- Year 6 revision

## As scientists we will:

- Properties and changing materials
- Sort and classify materials according to their properties
  - Investigate thermal conductors and insulators.
  - Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution
  - Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating by separating different mixtures
  - Identify and observe irreversible chemical changes
  - Carry out investigations, test theories and present results in graphs and tables
  - Find out about how chemists create new materials
