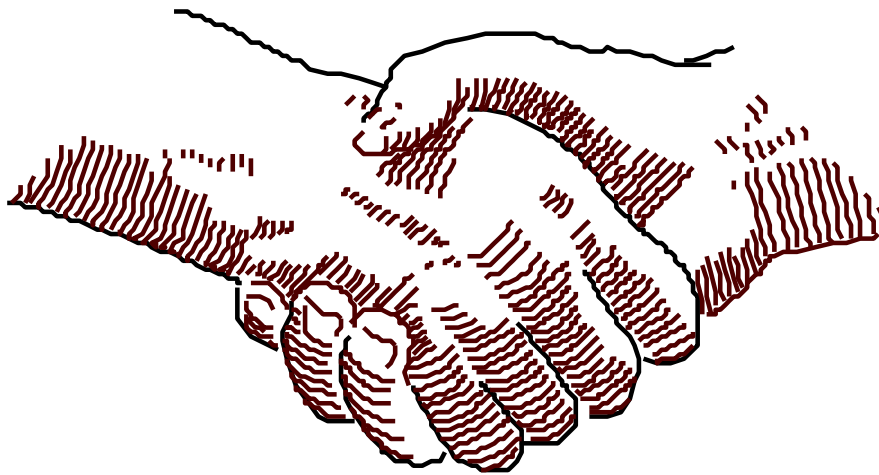

- provide regular consultation meetings and an annual report each year and contact you promptly with any concerns for your child's well being
- authorise absences only when appropriate and contact you if we are concerned about your child's absence from school
- Request evidence of medical advice sought in cases of regular absence due to illness.
- set, mark and monitor homework regularly, in keeping with the school's policy;

Parents/Carers

We will

- make sure our child attends school, is punctual and will inform the school of any absence on the day
- not take family holidays within school term times, other than in exceptional circumstances
- keep the school informed of important information relating to our child
- support the school's Behaviour Management Policy
- support and encourage in our child a commitment to the curriculum by providing the appropriate time and encouragement for home learning including hearing our child read at least three times per week
- attend consultation meetings, open days and special events and enter into the life of the school by taking advantage of facilities and activities offered
- Send the child to school clean, neat, tidy and wearing the appropriate school uniform and with correct PE kit.

The child:

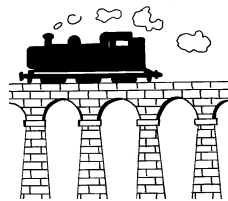
I will
