## Intent

### Vision Statement

At Chappel Primary school, History education is aimed to create a balance between coherent knowledge and an understanding of Britain's history; allowing effective questioning of how the past has influenced the present. Through this, it is intended that children will develop the skills to be able to question, think critically, explore evidence and sources, create arguments, and develop their own perspectives and conclusions on events and people from History.
