Curriculum Intent

At Chappel we have designed our RE curriculum following the Essex agreed syllabus enhanced with resources from Understanding Christianity. Successful learning will develop children who:

- Ask challenging questions about the meaning and purpose of life, beliefs, the self, issues of right and wrong, and what it means to be human.
- Have a secure knowledge and understanding of Christianity, other principal religions, and religious traditions that examine these questions, fostering personal reflection and spiritual development
- Explore their own beliefs (whether they are religious or non-religious), in the light of what they learn, as they examine issues of religious belief and faith and how these impact on personal, institutional and social ethics, and to express their responses. This also builds resilience to anti-democratic or extremist narratives
- Have a strong sense of identity and belonging, which helps them flourish within their communities and as citizens in a diverse society
- Have respect for others, including people with different faiths and beliefs, and challenge prejudice
- Consider their responsibilities to themselves and to others, and to explore how they might contribute to their communities and to wider society.
- Show empathy, generosity and compassion.
