As geographers we will:

- Name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 Oceans
- Use world maps, atlases and globes and simple compass directions.
- Develop geographical vocabulary
- Locate and name hot and cold areas in the world using atlases and globes in relation to Equator and the North/South Poles
- Identify similarities/differences in physical/human geography between a UK seaside town and a non-European coastal area.



As writers we will:

- Rewrite a familiar story
- Discuss sequence of events in books
- Ask and answer questions
- Participate in discussions about texts, explaining their understanding of what they have read so far
- Predict what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far
- Participate in discussions about texts, explaining their understanding of what they have read so far.
- Use subordination (as, when)
- Use co-ordination (and, so, but)
- Use expanded noun phrases

As Mathematicians we will:

- Count forwards and backwards
- Identify one more and one less.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers
- Read and write numbers in numerals and in words.
- Use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most and least.
- Compare and order numbers and use <, > and = signs.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)

As scientists we will

- Compare the differences between things that are living, dead and have never been alive
- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited
- Describe how different habitats provide the basic needs for animals and plants
- Identify a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats
- Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain
- Identify and name different sources of food
- Ask simple questions.
- Observe closely, using simple equipment.
- Gather and record data to help in answering questions.
